### ABORTION ACCESS

1 [SB111](#) by Senator Beth Mizell

Requires proof of identification from parents for an minor to obtain an abortion based upon parental consent and allows court-ordered counseling be required in judicial bypass cases.

Status: This bill Passed House (93 Yes-0 No) and Passed Senate (29 Yes-6 No) and became Act 165.

### SEXUAL HEALTH

2 [SB106](#) by Senator Wesley Bishop

Requires public colleges to provide information to students regarding the prevention of unplanned pregnancy and identify other ways to address unplanned pregnancies.

Status: This bill Passed House (95 Yes-2 No) and Passed Senate (35 Yes-0 No) and became Act 321.

3 [SB85](#) by Senator Yvonne Colomb

Authorizes the state Dept. of Education and the Dept. of Health to survey students regarding sexual risk behaviors (YRBS). Anonymous surveying allows information to be gathered confidentially and to be available for use to develop programs to improve teen health and to measure changes in behaviors.

Status: This bill Failed to pass Senate (14 Yes-22 No)

### ECONOMIC JUSTICE

4 [SB153](#) by Senator Troy Carter

Increase the minimum wage to \$8.50 per hour

Status: This bill failed in Senate Committee on Finance.
