<u>HB 488</u> 2016	Limits the availability of providers by requiring abortions to be performed only by a licensed physician who is board-certified in obstetrics and gynecology or family medicine or a resident under supervision of a physician who meets this requirement.	YES
<u>HB 606</u> 2016	Prohibits public funding for any family planning provider that also offers abortion services. This would prohibit Medicaid patients from receiving non-abortion care, like contraception and STI testing, at a clinic that also provides abortions.	YES
